	PORTFOLIO REVIEW LOOK FOR PROFESSIONALS WITH EXTENSIVE OUTDOOR AND VINEYARD WEDDING EXPERIENCE.
	READ REVIEWS CHECK TESTIMONIALS ON THEIR WEBSITE, GOOGLE, OR WEDDING DIRECTORIES TO LEARN ABOUT OTHERS' EXPERIENCES.
	SCHEDULE A CONSULTATION HAVE AN IN-DEPTH DISCUSSION ABOUT THEIR PROCESS, STYLE, AND YOUR VISION FOR THE WEDDING
DURING	THE BOOKING PROCESS
	DISCUSS VINEYARD-SPECIFIC EXPERTISE ENSURE THEY HAVE WORKED AT SIMILAR VENUES OR ARE COMFORTABLE WITH VINEYARD WEDDINGS.
	ASK ABOUT EQUIPMENT CONFIRM THEY USE PROFESSIONAL-GRADE GEAR AND HAVE BACKUPS FOR CAMERAS, LENSES, AND LIGHTING.
	INQUIRE ABOUT A PHOTOGRAPHY ASSISTANT IF YOUR GUEST LIST OR VENUE IS LARGE, A SECOND SHOOTER CAN CAPTURE MORE MOMENTS.
	CONFIRM DELIVERABLES UNDERSTAND WHAT'S INCLUDED, SUCH AS THE NUMBER OF EDITED PHOTOS, DIGITAL FILES, AND PRINT OPTIONS.
	UNDERSTAND THE CONTRACT OREVIEW TERMS, INCLUDING TIMELINES, CANCELLATION POLICIES, AND RIGHTS TO YOUR PHOTOS.
PRE-WED	DDING PLANNING
	VISIT THE VENUE TOGETHER WALK THE SITE WITH YOUR PHOTOGRAPHER TO IDENTIFY IDEAL PHOTO LOCATIONS AND SCOUT LIGHTING CONDITIONS.
	CREATE A SHOT LIST INCLUDE MUST-HAVE MOMENTS LIKE PRE-CEREMONY PREPARATIONS, GOLDEN HOUR PORTRAITS, AND SPECIFIC VINEYARD FEATURES.
	PLAN FOR WEATHER DISCUSS BACKUP PLANS FOR BAD WEATHER AND HOW THEY ADAPT TO CHALLENGING CONDITIONS.
	COORDINATE WITH YOUR PLANNER OSHARE THE DAY'S SCHEDULE TO ALIGN PHOTOGRAPHY TIMELINES WITH EVENTS.

ON YOUR	R WEDDING DAY
	PREPARE A PHOTOGRAPHY KIT INCLUDE TOUCH-UP ITEMS LIKE MAKEUP, HAIR PRODUCTS, AND A SMALL SEWING KIT FOR LAST- MINUTE ADJUSTMENTS.
	PROVIDE MEALS, SNACKS AND DRINKS KEEP THE PHOTOGRAPHY TEAM REFRESHED, ESPECIALLY DURING A FULL-DAY SHOOT.
	COMMUNICATE KEY MOMENTS ENSURE YOUR PHOTOGRAPHER KNOWS THE TIMING FOR CRITICAL MOMENTS LIKE THE FIRST LOO VOWS, AND TOASTS.
	ASSIGN A POINT PERSON DESIGNATE SOMEONE WHO KNOWS KEY GUESTS AND FAMILY MEMBERS TO ASSIST WITH GROUP PHOTOS.

	CONFIRM DELIVERY TIMELINES ASK HOW LONG IT WILL TAKE TO RECEIVE YOUR PHOTOS AND FINAL EDITS.
	REVIEW AND APPROVE PRINTS SELECT YOUR FAVORITE PHOTOS FOR ALBUMS OR WALL ART.
	SHARE AND CELEBRATE SHARE YOUR BEAUTIFUL VINEYARD WEDDING PHOTOS WITH FRIENDS, FAMILY, AND ON SOCIAL MEDIA.
